Sandy will have a metal surface pre-painted black with the pattern already on it for \$15.00. She will provide the paints or you can bring the colors you prefer. This will be a long class so we will be providing lunch (a chicken dish, salad, water, tea & a dessert). We will have a signup sheet at the January meeting if you are interested and more information will be provided.

Cost: For members who bring their own surface \$00.00

For members that want Sandy's prepared surface \$15.00

For non-members who bring their own surface \$30.00

For non-members that want Sandy's prepared surface \$45.00 (\$30 +15=\$45) The deadline to sign up for this seminar will be February 1st.

**Supplies to Bring:** a wet pallet, a small spray bottle to keep paint wet, a good liner brush, #2,4,6, & 8 filbert to dry brushes with, a stipple brush for the flower centers, water container & small containers to take paint home to finish if you don't get it all done.

If you bringing your own surface, it must have a base coat of black and the pattern already on it ready to paint February 24th.





# April 20th Michelle Shroyer. DecoArt Painted Easter Eggs with Butterflies

**MATERAILS SUPPLIED** 1 chicken size plastic egg, DecoArt Extreme Sheen paint 9 colors, pattern **COST:** \$3.00

MEMBERS BRING: palette, water container, paper towels

brushes - liner, flat or angle #6 or #8 for base-coating, small rounds #2 o#4, spotter

pencil, tracing paper, white graph paper, stylist, scissors, blue tape.

Reminder from Sherrie Colgain please bring the heat guns not hair dryers.

#### FOR MEMBERS PAINTING REMOTELY

The plastic eggs can be purchased from Michael's or Walmart they come in a carton of 12 and should be available the first part of March.

The paint is DecoArt Extreme Sheen. They say Michael,s will have but they did not in December and I ordered it from DecoArt, You need Deep Sapphire for base-coating and black for under coating the butterflies. These are fantasy butterflies so you can paint them any color you want. you can also use the paint you already have. Use some metallic. The Deep Sapphire is very dark so you may need to add some black to the blue you have.

Go to DecoArt, click inspiration & resources. Click your art. Go to the second page near the bottom, posted March 23, 2021. Click on the dark eggs with the butterflies.


