July 20th Bonnie Phillips: Water Soluble Oil Project

Christmas Moose - \$5 supply fee

Includes: Krylon #1311, Instructions, Water Soluble Oil, Painting Medium

NOTE: Print color picture and bring to class.

Acrylic and Water Soluble Oil

Prepare project background before class.

Stretched Canvas - 8x10", 9x12" or 11x14" (Print design size of choice)

Base coat project before class using a MEDIUM blue or mix blue with white. I used DecoArt True Blue #36 with White. Bring your base coat color(s) to class for touch up.

If using wood, brush mix DecoArt Multi-Purpose Sealer with your color choice blue acrylic. Let dry to touch then apply another coat without sealer. When dry lightly sand and wipe dust off with a damp paper towel.

Supplies to bring:

Brushes: If you do not have OIL Brushes use synthetic - Bring an assortment: #2,4, 6 & 8, 10, maybe a few Flats too. #1 or 2 Round/short liner, & Long Liner - Bring what you have as different brands tend to not be consistent with sizes. If project is larger than 8x10" use larger brushes.

Wipe Out Tool - I will have some to loan. New roll of paper towels - make a pad with several folded over to wipe brush and tear a number with the grain into quarters. 2 Water Containers or divided container - AFTER filling one container/side add liquid soap to avoid bubbles. Palette Paper on the pad, Q Tips

This project may take a little longer so you may want to bring a snack.

For those who do not bring their own supplies, the instructor will provide materials for class use. Participants will receive a reference photo and an information sheet to take home, along with their completed project.

We'll be drawing a couple simple landscapes similar to these:































Meeting Minutes: Secretary: Jan Zerbe
