June 15th Kathy Swigon: is teaching a patriotic design in honor of Flag Day.

The June meeting project is American Zen Eagle designed by Sharon Bond. She is donating the line drawing and base coat instructions to us. It's painted with DecoArt acrylics and finished with Zentangle style details. I will have a limited number of parchment paper surfaces available at the May meeting with the pattern applied for \$1 ea. Or you may use the surfaces of your choice. I did a sample on a tin wall pocket with a dark blue background as well as the parchment paper. I used JoSonja Harbor Blue but DecoArt Ultramarine, Midnight, Deep Midnight or Navy Blue would work well. Line drawings and paint base coat instructions are in the newsletter



DecoArt colors: Black, Payne's Grey, Midnight Blue, Winter Blue, Snow

White, Warm White, Bleached Sand, Buttermilk, Cashmere Beigh, Spicy Mustard or Marigolds, Burnt Sienna, Tomato or other red (optional).

Other supplies: Black fine tip permanent marker—Sharpie or Ident pen, star stencil, assorted sizes, eraser, graphite paper white or grey depending on background, other usual acrylic supplies

Brushes: #3 round, 3/4" flat for base coating, #6 filbert, #1 short liner, 3/8" angle, small stencil brush Visit Sharon's Etsy shop for more designs.

Christmas Moose

Acrylic and Water Soluble Oil

Prepare project before the meeting:

Paint the 8x10" Stretched Canvas using medium or medium light blue acrylic - or -

If using wood, brush mix <u>water based sealer</u> with the base coat acrylic. When dry <u>lightly sand</u> then wipe dust off with a damp paper towel.

Under coat antlers & sign with white acrylic. Undercoat body with Burnt Umber

acrylic. DO NOT UNDERCOAT FACE AND NOSE. Paint eyes and nose nostrils with Black acrylic.

Supplies to bring:

Brushes: If you do not have OIL Brushes use synthetic - #8 Bright, #10-12 Bright, #1 or 2 Round/short liner, & Long Liner - Bring what you have as different brands tend to not be consistent with sizes. The main thing is you will need brights because of the shorter bristles & short /lliner for close work.

Wipe Out Tool - I will have some to loan

New roll of paper towels

2 Water Containers or divided container - AFTER filling one container add liquid soap. Palette Paper on the pad



Meeting Minutes: Secretary: Jan Zerbe

FSDA May 18, 2024 Minutes

Call to order: President Sherrie Colgan, called the meeting to order at 9:50 AM, at the Messiah Lutheran Church.

Tips and Tricks: Kathy Edwards. Kathy spoke on different watercolor paper weights. Student grade paper is made with paper and a minimum of sizing on the paper. Sizing allows the paint to sit on top and not soak in. Cutting watercolor paper – fold and press down well, fold paper back and forth then the paper will tear easily. To protect a watercolor project, Kathy recommends using (Jacquard) Dorland's Wax Medium (Amazon). Wipe project with the wax and rub off any extra wax with a soft towel. Watercolor mistakes- use a Mr. Clean sponge, wet a small part of the sponge (Kathy suggests cutting the sponge into smaller pieces) and it will help in cleaning up the project mistakes. Excess graphite on the watercolor paper, use a kneaded rubber eraser rolled into a snake and then roll it over the pencil lines. This will pick up excessive graphite. To make waterproof board on a porous surface, i.e. cardboard, use packing tape and cover the entire surface. Now the surface is waterproof.


